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6.12 Municipality of Magnetawan Council Resolution regarding Invest Ready Certified Site Designation

9.2.3 Report FIN-2026-003 Municipal Performance Measurement Program Report for 2024

-p.129 re status of bridges and culverts; it appears that 8 bridges and culverts require repair. What is the timing of repair for these structures?

The data referenced in Report FIN-2026-003 is based on the 2023 OSIM report, which was used to meet the Municipal Performance Measurement Program reporting requirements for the period ending December 31, 2024. The Township has since received an updated 2025 OSIM report, and the revised condition assessments and recommended works have been incorporated into the 2026 Capital Budget and long-term forecast.

Based on the most current information, the timing of repairs for the identified bridges and culverts is as follows:

- Cook's Bridge – 2027 - \$750K
- Leslie Road West Culvert (Structure 0005) – No longer requires capital works based on the 2025 OSIM report
- Concession 1 Culvert (Structure 0006) – 2027 -\$25K
- Boundary Road Culvert on Gore Road (Structure 0008) – \$190K – Responsibility of the Township of North Dumfries ; not included in the Township's forecast.
- Victoria Road Culvert Over Galt Creek – 2033 - \$170K
- Ellis Road Culvert over Puslinch Lake/Irish Creek – 2030 – \$700K



- Concession 2 Culvert (Structure 2012) – 2029 - \$160K
- Victoria Road Culvert north of Leslie (Structure 2013) – 2033 - \$200K

In addition, the 2025 OSIM report identified the following capital work that was not noted in the 2023 report:

- Little's Bridge Load Testing and Minor Rehabilitation– 2028 - \$45K
