Minutes of March 28, 2011

The meeting was held at the Puslinch Township offices at 7:30 pm. Committee members present were Chair Lynn Crow, Secretary and Council representative -Township Deputy Clerk - Heather Krouskie, Doug Mast, Don Aubin, Mary Tivy and John Levak.

Adoption of the Minutes

BUSINESS ARISING:

- Lynn made a presentation to Council on December 13, 2010 at the Puslinch Community Centre. The presentation was entitled "Architectural Annals of Puslinch".
- Photos and information on Puslinch Churches still need to go to the Ontario Heritage Trust.
- Heather and Lynn will check the land registry records to confirm the date the University of Guelph purchased the Arkell/Kay farm. It was confirmed that on November 21, 1956 the land transfer agreement was registered between Wm. J. Kay and the Province.
- Heather confirmed that the Isles house and barn have been listed in the Township's inventory and a sticker has been added in the inventory binder.

COMMUNICATIONS:

1. **Stephanie Barber email of January 21, 2011** – Stephanie was looking for digital photographs of heritage sites that have “passed on”, as well as those that are still “alive and well” for a video she is producing. She also mentioned that she would be posting these on the internet. (The two town halls, one in Morriston which was demolished, and the other in Aberfoyle that was moved to what is now called Country Heritage Park at Milton could represent Puslinch without getting into property releases from homeowners.) **Lynn and Heather will meet and prepare a response to Stephanie.**

2. **Telephone conversation with Paul Mazetti on March 3, 2011** – Mr. Mazetti, owner of Woodlands/Vimy Ridge Farm wanted to let the Puslinch Heritage Committee know that his farm is going to be included in the Doors Open, Guelph tour on April 30, 2011. There will be two tours showing both the Saunders’ house and the Sorby horse barn.

3. **Photographs donated to P.H.C.** – The following photographs have been donated to the Committee:
 - a) John Scott farmhouse, at Lot 14, Rear Gore. It was plaqued in 2000.
 - b) James Scott/Earon house and barn was at Lot 15, Rear Concession 7 but is no longer standing.
