5. REGULAR BUSINESS

1. Chair Appointment Process

To provide clarification, Ms. Karen Landry, CAO/Clerk, advised that in the absence of the Chair, the Vice-Chair assumes the role and responsibilities of the Chair.

Ms. Landry advised that at the August 10, 2016 Council meeting, Council will be selecting a representative to fill the Councillor Vacancy. The appointment of a Council representative to the Recreation Committee will occur at a future meeting of Council.

As the Committee does not meet in August, Ms. Landry advised that the appointment of a Chair of the Committee will be determined at the September meeting.



2. Pickleball Verbal Update

Ms. Margaret Hauwert provided the Committee with an update regarding her meeting with a representative from the Pickleball Association.

To assist with promoting pickleball, Ms. Hauwert expressed that the Pickleball Association is willing to assist a group if they are seeking to begin a pickleball league utilizing the Optimist Recreation Centre gymnasium.

Members of the Committee advised that there is a desire for pickleball in the Township, but there would have to be a group that is seeking to facilitate the organization of a league, such as a group of residents or an organization such as the YMCA/YWCA.

The Committee advised that they would like staff to connect with Linda Killough, Programs Manager, YMCA/YWCA, to continue discussions about the YMCA/YWCA using Township facilities for various programs such as pickleball, PD days, and holiday activities.

3. Facility Financials and Revenues Discussion

Mr. Kevin Johnson inquired with Township Staff about the facility financials that the Committee received at the previous Committee meeting. More specifically, Mr. Johnson asked staff whether it is accurate that the revenues from 2016 are down in comparison to the previous year.

Ms. Marissa Herner advised that over the past few months the Township has been in a state of transition. More specifically, Ms. Herner advised that the Township has inputted all facility data in to Keystone, which is a more comprehensive electronic system for tracking facility revenues that is connected to Accounts Receivable. Ms. Herner advised that a new module has been released in Keystone that allows Staff to print monthly financials that will capture in detail the financials for each facility.

Ms. Herner noted that it would be inaccurate to compare the monthly revenues from 2015 and 2016, as the process for collecting and quantifying this data has changed with the integration of the facility rentals in to Keystone.

Beginning at the next meeting in September, Ms. Herner advised that the Committee can expect the new facility financials for their review.

4. Basketball Court ≠

Ms. June Williams expressed to the Committee that the Optimist Club will be supporting the initiative to have a basketball court in the park on Boreham Drive with Council's approval.

Ms. Williams advised that the Optimist Club have visited the park with Mr. Don Creed, Director of Public Works and Parks, to determine where the basketball court would be located and ensure there is suitable elevation and drainage.

In regards to landscaping, Ms. Williams advised that Dave Bouck of Davan Landscaping has volunteered to lead the construction of the basketball court. Ms. Williams advised that the Optimist Club is speaking with other local contractors with respect to sourcing material suppliers and "in kind" assistance.



The Committee requested that the Optimist Club provide a sketch of the basketball court, in addition to expenses and who would be responsible for said expenses prior to submitting their proposal to Council.

The Committee supports the installation of a basketball court at the park on Boreham Drive, subject to confirmation being provided by The Optimist Club that they will be responsible for all cost.

Dear Karen and Jessie,

Thank you for taking time today to meeting with me to discuss how the YMCA-YWCA of Guelph can continue to grow our partnership with the Township of Puslinch.

As discussed today, we are committed to offering PD Day Camps, Christmas Break Camp and March Break Camp for the 2016/2017 school year. We will wait to hear from you regarding the rate of rental for the space to complete our planning and communication.

We would like to express interest in entering into discussion with the Township of Puslinch to offer programming at the Puslinch Community Centre/Optimist Recreation Centre. As we discussed the opportunities are endless, however, managing the fiscal responsibility of the offering is something that we would like to discuss. From our conversation, the YMCA-YWCA of Guelph would rent the space based upon an agreed price and offer the programming, therefore assuming all the cost and risk. Is there an opportunity to have discussion on how we could share this responsibility? The YMCA-YWCA of Guelph currently operates on a membership based platform; we would have to develop a way to sell our programming (maybe in the format of a punch card as we discussed) at the Puslinch Community Centre/Optimist Recreation Centre.

Programming we could develop for the residents of the Township of Puslinch in 2016/2017:

Fall 2016 – LIT- Leadership in Training - This leadership program strives to develop today's young people into the leaders of tomorrow.

Competencies covered in this program are communication skills, customer service, behaviour management/child guidance policies, resume writing 101, health and safety, High Five Principles of Healthy Child Development Certification, Basic First Aid and CPR certification, goal setting and personal growth. The training would be customized to cover the policies and procedures the Township of Puslinch/Optimist Recreation Centre as required.

Programming for 0-5 year youth (parents must be in attendance) This programming would be offered free of charged

Wake Up and Shake Up - Want to get your dance on? Preschoolers will participate in an active program with music where they will learn movements through dance and games while listening to different genres of music each day.

Preschool Sports Skills - Preschoolers will have a chance to try out different sports each day, including soccer, basketball and hockey. Programs are designed for preschoolers to have a chance to develop their skills in a variety of sports, in a fun and safe environment.

Creative Zone - Preschoolers have the chance to express their creative side in Preschool Creative Zone! Participants will have the chance to explore a variety of creative themes including painting, dance, dress-up and drama activities.
