Hi Ken,

We have reviewed the information provided, and today were on-site with the landlord to walk the area and see if moving the proposed installation would be possible to the areas you suggested.

Unfortunately, relocating the proposed installation to the areas indicated, and the associated road to access it, would cause too much disruption to the ongoing farming operations in the field to be acceptable to the landlord and is not a viable alternative. As a compromise, Rogers is agreeable to moving it to the northeast along the property line to the extent possible (another 20-30m perhaps), however, as you may know there is a wet area near the stand of trees coming out from the property line and we have to locate at least 30m from its surrounding stable top of bank.
