

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PUSLINCH**BY-LAW NUMBER XX/14**

Being a by-law to authorize the temporary borrowing of funds to meet current expenditures of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch ("Township") during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2014.

WHEREAS Section 407 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25 as amended provides authority for a Council by By-Law to authorize the temporary borrowing, until the taxes are collected and other revenues are received, of the amounts that Council considers necessary to meet the current expenditures of the municipality for the year;

AND WHEREAS the total amount which may be borrowed from all sources at any one time to meet the current expenditures of the Municipality, except with the approval of the Municipal Board, is limited by Section 407 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended;

AND WHEREAS the total amount previously borrowed by the Township pursuant to Section 407 that has not been repaid is NIL;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Treasurer be and the same are hereby authorized on behalf of the Township to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE TORONTO DOMINION BANK ("TD") a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$1,500,000.00 to meet, until taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Township for the year as permitted by Section 407 of the Municipal Act and to give to TD promissory notes or notes, as the case may be, sealed with the Township's corporate seal and signed by the Mayor and Treasurer for the sums borrowed with interest at the TD's prime interest which shall be agreed upon from time to time with TD.
2. That the total amount borrowed at any one time plus any outstanding amounts of principal borrowed and accrued interest shall not exceed,
 - a) from January 1 to September 30 in the year, 50 percent of the total estimated revenues of the municipality as set out in the budget adopted for the year; and
 - b) from October 1 to December 31 in the year, 25 per cent of the total estimated revenues of the municipality as set out in the budget adopted for the year.
3. For purposes of this By-Law the estimated revenues referred to in section 2 do not include revenues derivable or derived from: a) any borrowing, including through any issue of debentures; b) a surplus, including arrears of taxes, fees or charges; or c) a transfer from the capital fund, reserve funds or reserves.
4. All sums borrowed pursuant to this by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed pursuant to the Act in this year for any purpose will, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Township for the current year and when this revenue is received.

5. The Treasurer is authorized and directed to apply in payment for all sums borrowed plus interest, all of the monies collected or received on account in respect of taxes levied for the current year or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for this purpose.

BY-LAW NUMBER XX/14

Being a By-Law to appoint two
(2) Temporary Deputy Fire
Chiefs and to repeal By-law
Number 44/09.

WHEREAS the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, S.C. 1997, as amended, provides that the Council may by by-law establish and regulate a Fire Department and appoint a Fire Chief to carry out the several duties and responsibilities thereof;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch enacts as follows:

1. Joshua Shepherd is hereby appointed to the position of Temporary Deputy Fire Chief of Administration with the Puslinch Volunteer Fire Department.
2. The following persons are hereby appointed to the position of Temporary Deputy Fire Chief of Operations with Puslinch Volunteer Fire Department:
 - a) Robert Frosch Commencing on April 03, 2014 to June 30, 2014
 - b) Ken Tosh Commencing on July 01, 2014 to Sept. 30, 2014
 - c) Martin Yates Commencing on Oct. 01, 2014 to Dec. 31, 2014
 - d) Scott Priest Commencing on Jan. 01, 2015 to March 31, 2015
 - e) John Uptegrove Commencing April 01, 2015 to June 30, 2015
2. The Temporary Deputy Fire Chiefs are responsible to the Chief of the Department.
3. The Temporary Deputy Fire Chief of Administration shall report to the Chief of the Department on the activities of the Divisions that are their responsibility and carry out the orders of the Chief and in the absence of the Chief, has all the powers and shall perform all duties of the Chief.
4. This by-law repeals by-law number 44/09.
5. This by-law shall come into effect the day it is passed by Council and remains in force until repealed.

Being a by-law to authorize the entering into an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Rural Affairs under the Rural Economic Development Program for the Website Development and Enhancement Project.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25 authorizes a municipality to enter into Agreements;

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PUSLINCH

BY-LAW NUMBER XX/14

Being a by-law to confirm the proceedings of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch at its meeting held on April 2, 2014.

WHEREAS by Section 5 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its Council;

AND WHEREAS by Section 5, Subsection (3) of the *Municipal Act*, a municipal power including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 8, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the proceedings of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch at its meeting held April 2, 2014 be confirmed and adopted by By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) The action of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Puslinch, in respect of each recommendation contained in the reports of the Committees and each motion and resolution passed and other action taken by the Council at said meeting are hereby adopted and confirmed.
- 2) The Head of Council and proper official of the Corporation are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said action of the Council.
- 3) The Head of Council and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents required by statute to be executed by them, as may be necessary in that behalf and the Clerk authorized and directed to affix the seal of the said Corporation to all such documents.
