We are seeking clarification regarding Councils intention for the proposed Community Safety Zone extension.

We understood that the proposed extension was only to extend the southern limit of the Safety Zone to include all of the lands within the 50km/h speed zone. At the December 4th 2013 Council meeting, Council adopted resolution 2013-318, which gave Township consents to have the Community Safety Zone extended southward to include all of Morriston. This extension would not only include the entire 50 km/h zone but a portion of the 80km/h zone as well.

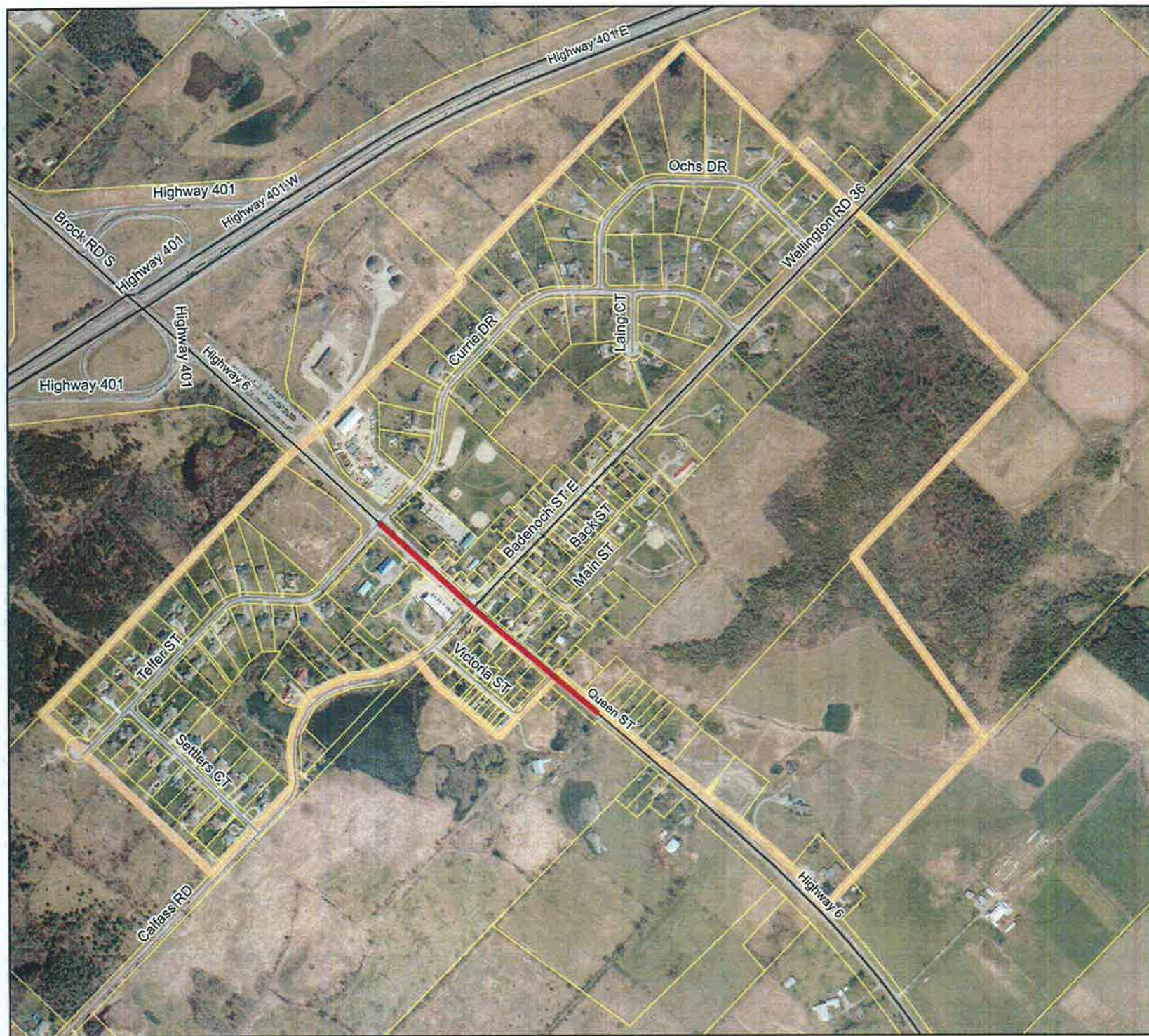


Legend

- Urban Centre Boundary

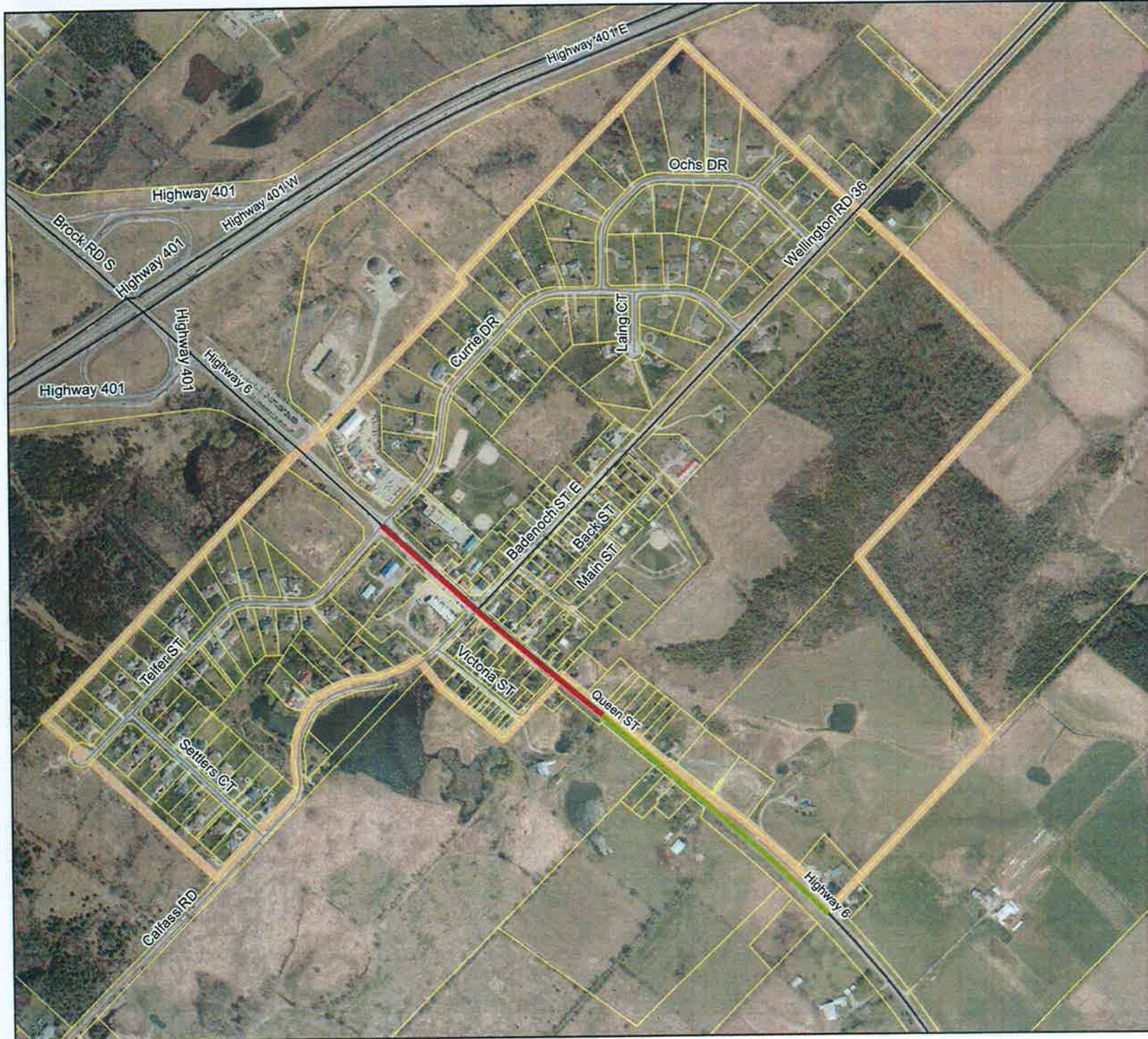

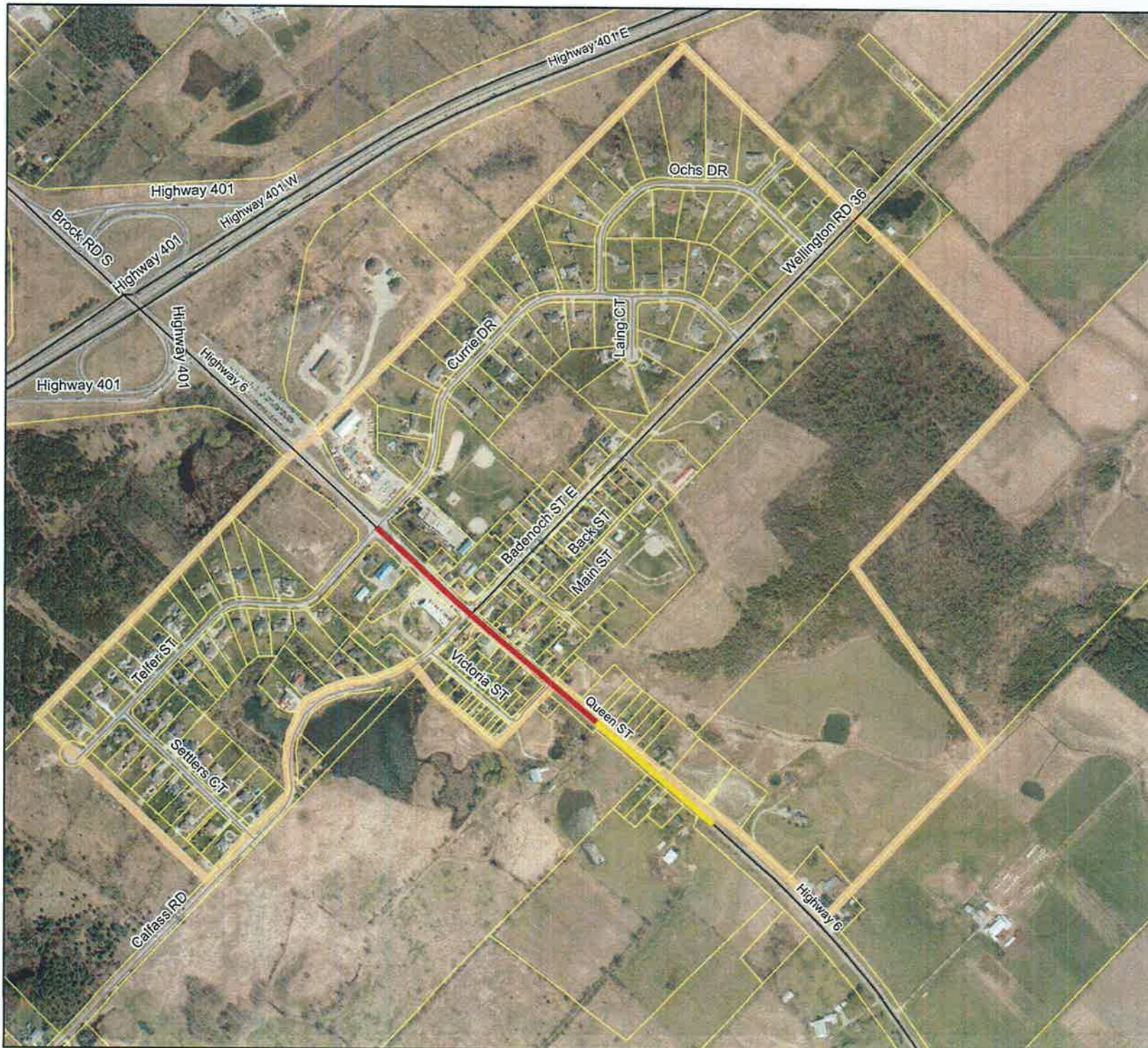

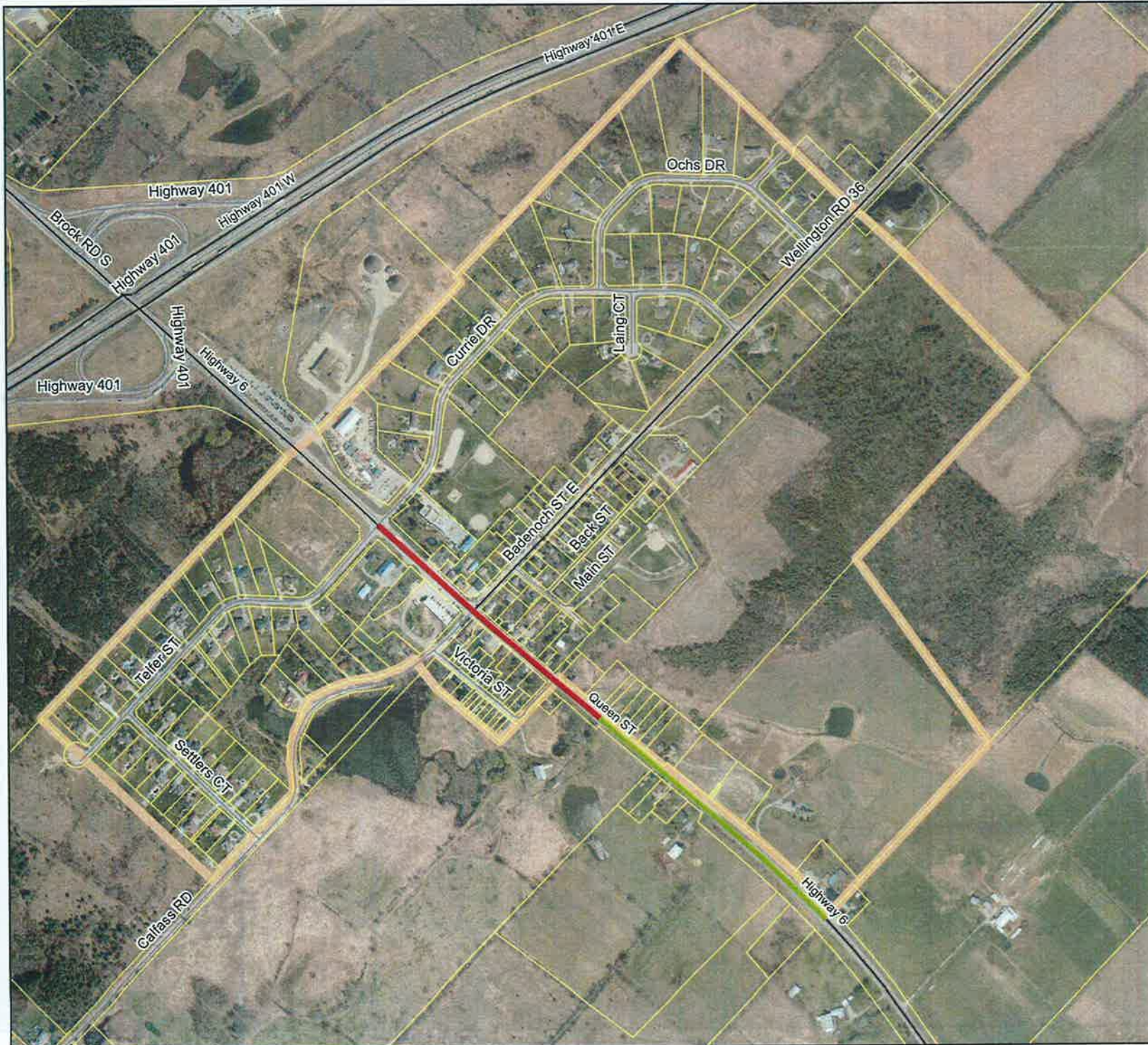
