6. **REGULAR BUSINESS**

- Satellite Fire Station Concept Update
 Karen Landry advised that she met with Deputy Chief Goode and Mary
 Hasan, Director of Finance/Treasurer and discussed the additional
 information requested by the Committee and format for presenting the results
 of the Satellite Fire Station Trial once the trial period concludes.
- 2. Merged Computer Network Karen Landry advised that a majority of the work to merge the Fire and Rescue Services Network with the rest of the Township has been completed. Staff continues to work with HLB to resolve any outstanding issues. Steve Goode recognized the efforts of Josh Shepherd as he provided assistance to HLB related through the transfer.
- Fireworks By-law Update regarding Public Meeting
 Karen Landry advised that the Public Meeting has been set for November 6,
 2013 at 3:30 p.m.
- 4. Preliminary review of the Draft Open Burning By-law
 The Committee completed a preliminary review of the draft by-law. It was
 noted that it is being recommended that permits be issued annually rather
 than every three (3) months, and that a fee of \$20.00 be imposed. Further,
 staff advised that the current by-law incorrectly stated a requirement that
 open air burning not occur within a distance of 150 metres from any building
 or structure, etc. It was noted that this distance is not achievable in most
 areas of the municipality. The proposed by-law sets this distance at 15
 metres. Also, the current by-law establishes a distance of 50 feet between a



fire and any building or structure, etc and the proposed by-law changes the separation distance to 10 metres being 33 feet.

5. Fees Review

The Committee reviewed the proposed fees schedule.

6. Future Initiatives Update

Councillor Stokley requested that the feasibility of collecting funds for the perpetual maintenance of reservoirs be included in the comments section of the future initiatives listing.
