

TENT INFORMATION GUIDE

When is a building permit required for a tent?

- When a tent is more than 60 square meters (645 sqft) in area,
- When a group of tents spaced less than 3 meters (10') apart are more than 60 square meters in aggregate ground area (645 sqft), or
- When a tent is attached to another building.

What are drawing requirements for a tent permit?

- A site plan (to scale & dimensioned) or survey of your lot showing the location of the tent in relation to other structures & property lines, location of fire access routes and washrooms.
- Structural drawings showing framing and anchorage details. If an individual tent is more than 225 square meters (2420 sqft) in area the drawings must be stamped and signed by a professional engineer.
- Floor plans showing the location of means of egress and exit facilities, seating plan and occupant load.
- Fabric specifications certificate must be provided. Material shall meet the requirements of CAN/ULC S109 or NFPA 701

****Note:** Along with the above required information, a complete building permit application must be provided.

What are Building Code requirements for a tent?

- All tents must be at least 3 meters from property lines and other structures & tents on the same property.
- The grounds enclosed by a tent and extending for 3 meters beyond the perimeter
 of the tent must be level, and cleared of all flammable and combustible material or
 vegetation.
- Additional requirements apply to tents with sidewalls, bleachers, or individual tents
 or groups of tents less than 3 meters apart and more than 225 square meters in
 aggregate area.

All tents must comply with 'SECTION 2.9 TENTS AND AIR-SUPPORTED STRUCTURES' of the Ontario Fire Protection and Prevention Act.



What is included in the cost of my building permit?

- The cost of your permit includes the review of your proposed project to ensure building and zoning compliance, issuing of your building permit and the necessary building inspections.
- Please visit the Township website for the current building permit fees. All permit application fees are paid at time of application; we accept cheque and online payment by credit card, a convenience fee of 1.75% will be added to online payments.

How long does it take before I get my permit?

Once a complete application is made, the permit will be reviewed within a
maximum of 10 business days. Within that time period, your permit will be issued,
or more information regarding your project may be requested by the building
department.

What inspections will be done?

- Once erection of the tent is complete, a final inspection is required.
- All mandatory inspection will be listed on the permit.

Booking Inspections

Please make your inspection request through **Cloudpermit**. If you have questions, you can email services@puslinch.ca or call the office at 519-763-1226 ext 181.

Inspections are conducted every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Inspection requests must be received no later than 3:00pm the business day before the requested date. (Example: Friday inspection must be requested before 3:00pm Thursday afternoon).
