

Are you on the Voters' List?

Notice of Voters' List and Start of the Revision Period for the 2022 Municipal and School Board Election

The Voters' List is a list of eligible electors who can vote in the 2022 Municipal Election. From September 1 until the close of voting on voting day (October 24), eligible electors may submit an application to have their name added to or removed from the voters' list, or to have their information amended.

Applications can be made to:

- 1. add or remove your name from the voters' list; or
- 2. correct information relating to your qualifying address or school support

between September 1, 2022 and October 21, 2022, Monday to Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Municipal Office; or on Voting Day, October 24, 2022 at the location designated for you to vote.

To be an eligible elector, you must:

- be a Canadian citizen,18 years of age or older
- a resident of the Township of Puslinch, an owner or tenant of land in the Township of Puslinch, or the spouse of such an owner or tenant in the Township of Puslinch, and
- must not be prohibited from voting by law.

Voters may inspect the list to ensure their names are on it as well as make inquiries regarding the status of their school support at the Municipal Office, 7404 Wellington Road 34. Alternatively, Voters may call the Clerk's Office starting September 1, 2022 during regular business hours at 519-763-1226 x 5.
