

Puslinch By Design Phases 5 and 6 Land Options Council Meeting & Open House

The Township of Puslinch, in collaboration with the County of Wellington, is undertaking an important planning study to identify potential employment lands within the Township.

Commencing in the summer of 2024, the study began with a comprehensive assessment of current conditions, including an analysis of factors related to employment lands such as transportation and land use. This foundational research has provided essential background information for the study.

The Township will be holding an in-person Open House where a brief presentation of Phases 5 and 6 of the study will be provided. Phase 5 outlines the rationale for the preferred land use plan, along with the policy designations and maps, infrastructure needs, design guidelines and implementation guidance. Phase 6 prepares the Official Plan Amendment policies and mapping based on the Preferred Land Use Plan.

Members of the public are invited to speak with staff and Township Consultants. The details of the Open House are noted below:

July 9, 2025 Puslinch Community Centre, 23 Brock Road South Beginning at 7:00 p.m.

There will also be a Special Council meeting (in-person and via Zoom) on July 23, 2025 held at the Municipal Office, 7404 Wellington Road 34, beginning at 10:00 a.m., to consider and make a decision on the study results and the Official Plan Amendment.
