

Whereas the Committee recognizes the importance of safe, accessible, and continuous pedestrian infrastructure for youth and community members travelling over Highway 401 between Morriston and Aberfoyle; and,

Whereas the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario (MTO) is undertaking construction projects in the area, which may present opportunities to improve local active transportation connections;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Township's Youth Advisory Committee recommends that Council submit the following comments to the MTO:

1. Improve sidewalk access and pedestrian safety between Morriston and Aberfoyle; and
2. Consider integrating enhanced sidewalk and active transportation infrastructure as part of any current or future construction projects occurring over Highway 401; and,
