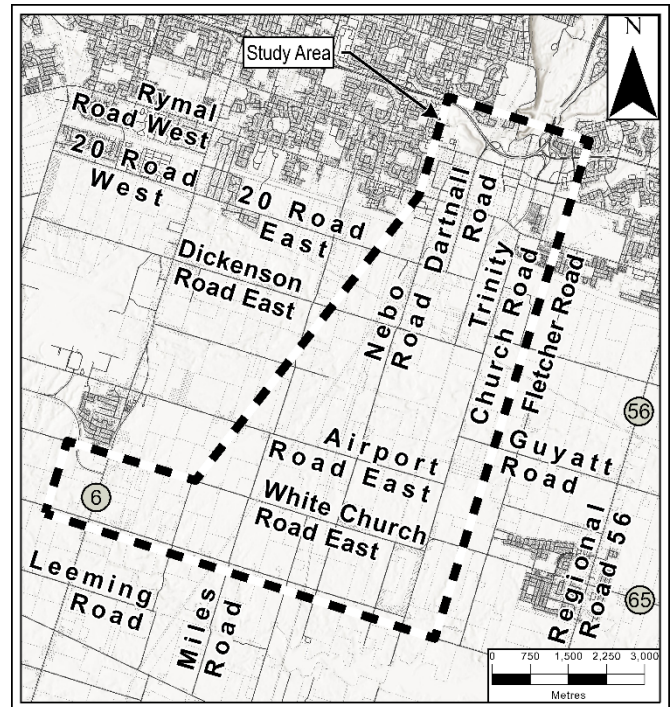
The Study

The 2018 Hamilton Transportation Master Plan identified the creation of a new link between Highway 6 South and Red Hill Business Park (RHBP) as a potential solution to improve the efficiency of goods movement in South Hamilton. The City of Hamilton has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) to evaluate options for a new link between Highway 6 South and RHBP, connecting to the John C. Munro Hamilton International Airport and its surrounding employment lands to address long-term transportation needs by enhancing people and goods movement, alleviating operational and connectivity challenges, and supporting economic growth in South Hamilton.

Process

This project is being carried out as a Schedule C project under the Municipal Engineers Association *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (February 2024). A design concept will be recommended in consultation with agencies, stakeholders, Indigenous communities and the public and documented in an Environmental Study Report (ESR), prepared for public review at the conclusion of the study.

The first Public Information Centre (PIC) is planned to review the problem/opportunity statement, the alternatives and gather public comments. Additional PIC's are planned throughout the study.
