



**Notice of Passing of Community Improvement Project Area By-law No. 2026-042 and
Supporting Local Business in Puslinch: a Township-wide Community Improvement
Plan By-law No. 2026-043**

TAKE NOTICE that the Township of Puslinch Council passed a Township-wide Community Improvement Project Area By-law No. 2026-042 and the Supporting Local Business in Puslinch: A Township-wide Community Improvement Plan By-law No. 2026-043 on June 17th, 2026, under section 28 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13*, as amended,

AND TAKE NOTICE that only the registered owner of any land to which the by-laws would apply, a specified person, and a public body who, before the by-law was passed, made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to Council, may appeal the decision of Council to the Ontario Land Tribunal. An appeal must set out the reasons for the appeal, including the specific part(s) of the by-law(s) being appealed and the reasons in support of the appeal. A notice of appeal must be filed with the Municipal Clerk either through the Ontario Land Tribunal e-file service at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service/> or by mail to the Township Clerk at 7404 Wellington Road 34, Puslinch ON N0B 2J0, and must be received no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 15, 2026. The notice of appeal must be accompanied by the applicable Ontario Land Tribunal appeal fee and a completed appeal form. The appeal fee must be paid in accordance with the Ontario Land Tribunal's current fee requirements. A copy of the appeal form and information regarding appeal fees are available from the Ontario Land Tribunal website at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/appeals-process/>.

AND TAKE NOTICE that public input has been received, considered and has informed the decision of Council. The decision of Council is final if a notice of appeal is not received on or before the last day for filing a notice of appeal.

By-law 2026-042 designates all lands within the municipal boundaries of the Township of Puslinch as a Community Improvement Project Area.

By-law 2026-043 adopts the Supporting Local Business in Puslinch: A Township-wide Community Improvement Plan for the Community Improvement Project Area.

An appeal may be filed in respect of either or both By-law 2026-042 and By-law 2026-043.

If no appeals are received on or before July 15, 2026, the by-laws will come into force on July 16, 2026.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-laws were passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to Council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Land Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

A key map has not been provided because the Community Improvement Project Area applies to all lands within the municipal boundaries of the Township of Puslinch.
